Local governing body (LGB)

Individuals who sit on local governing bodies (LGBs) are referred to as 'local governors'. The directors / trustees can delegate governance functions to the local level. Trustees have complete discretion over what is delegated to each LGB. At St Joachim's the following have been delegated to the LGB:

- Curriculum policies,
- Target setting and monitoring of standards
- The setting of the budget and monitoring,
- The appointment of staff other than Assistant Heads and the Headteacher
- Strategic development of the premises
- Admissions

Three sub-committees of the LGB report to the LGB:

- Curriculum & Staffing Committee - Chair – Aine Burke
- Finance & Premises Committee - Chair – Stuart James
- Admissions – Chair – Aine Burke
- Headteacher's Performance Management – Chair – Michael Coleman

In addition the LGB has committees for staff and pupil discipline and appeals. These committees may comprise of governors who are available, as these may be called on an ad hoc basis should the need arise.
