## Agreement for Pupils

*To help me do well at school, I will do my best to:*

1. Not miss school, unless unwell, and always be on time.
2. Work hard, and listen carefully to instructions.
3. Talk at home about what I learn at school.
4. Ask the teacher or someone at home for help if I find my work hard.
5. Read or discuss my home reader books to someone at home.
6. Do all of my homework, including reading and learning.
7. Take care of books and other resources in my care.
8. Wear full school uniform including PE kit to show I belong to the school community.
9. Respect and allow other children who need to learn in peace without distraction.
10. Keep the school rules, behave well, and be polite and helpful to other pupils and teachers, classroom assistants, and all adults within the school community.

## Agreement for Parents/Carer

*To help my child do well at school, I will do my best to:*

1. Make sure that my child attends school regularly, and is consistently on time.
2. Support the Catholic education of my child by regularly attending Mass, and sharing in the life of the Parish.
3. Encourage my child to work hard, and listen to my child read at home.
4. Support my child with homework, and other opportunities for learning at home.
5. Ensure my child wears the correct uniform, and that it is the correct size and clean.
6. Collect my child on time after school.
7. Contact the school as soon as possible, by phone, email or in writing, if my child is absent.
8. Work with the school to try and make sure that my child behaves well, supporting the school's policy and guidelines for behaviour.
9. Attend open evenings, and school meetings arranged for parents, and reply to any communications from school, by phone, email or letter.
10. Support school trips financially, when reasonably requested, where appropriate / able.

## Agreement for the School

6. Welcome parents/carers into the life of the school, and keep you informed about general school matters, through fortnightly newsletters and letters home
7. Let you know regularly how your child is progressing
8. Set your child regular homework tasks, including reading and spelling, and mark and monitor it
9. Offer a broad and balanced curriculum which meets the needs of your child, including additional before and after school activities
10. To work in partnership with the parents and the parish to promote the best wellbeing for all our children
